This document is another way I live up to my promise to make you as self-sufficient as possible, while helping you keep your PC up and running longer.

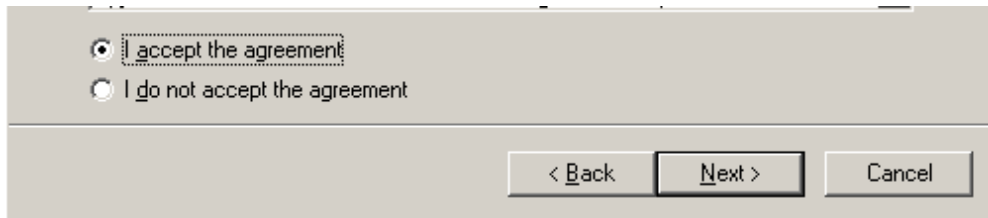
Of course, that means less frequent repeat business, so I have to ask you a favor:

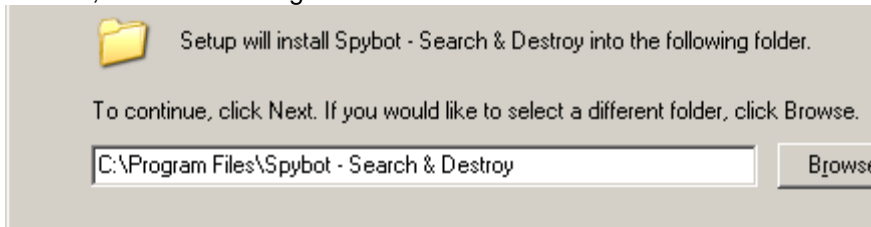

OK, on with the upgrade:

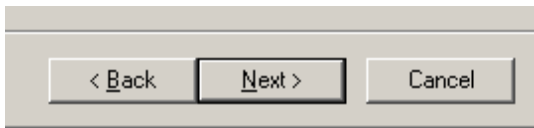
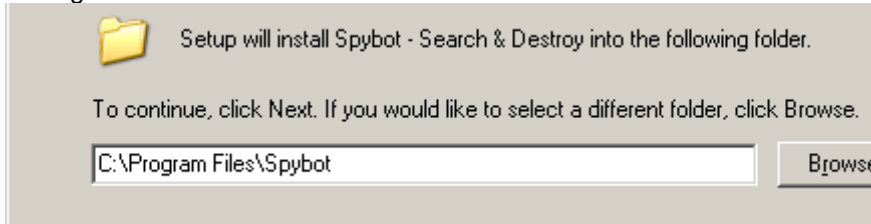
- 1) Download Spybot v1.6 and save it to your desktop.  
<http://www.spybot.info/en/mirrors/index.html>  
you don’t want to surf even trusted sites without your protective programs in place.
- 2) Next, from the start button open the control panel.
- 3) In the control panel, open the “add/remove programs” applet  
(on vista it’s moved from the top 3 on the list to the middle, under “Programs”)
- 4) Scroll down the list of programs loaded on your PC, highlight Spybot, and remove it.
- 5) Reboot your PC.
- 6) Double click on the icon on your desktop for the Spybot Install program you downloaded in step one.
- 7) Do what’s obvious (accept defaults) until you get to choices displayed below:
- 8) Select English, click next, accept the agreement ...



Careful, here's the changes:

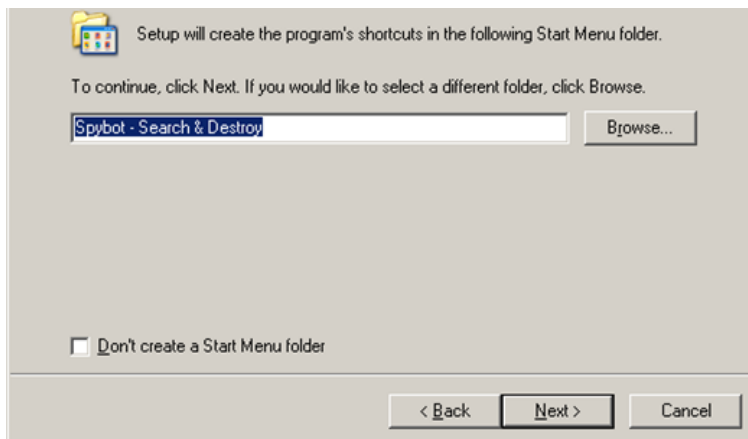
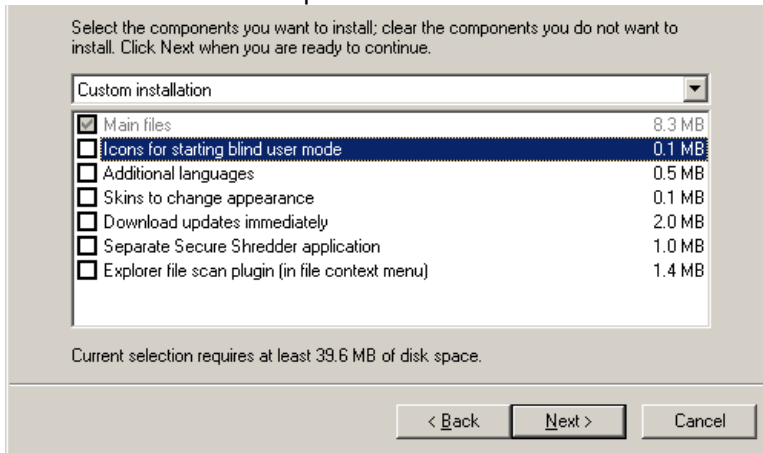


Change the folder to:

Make the top number Zero



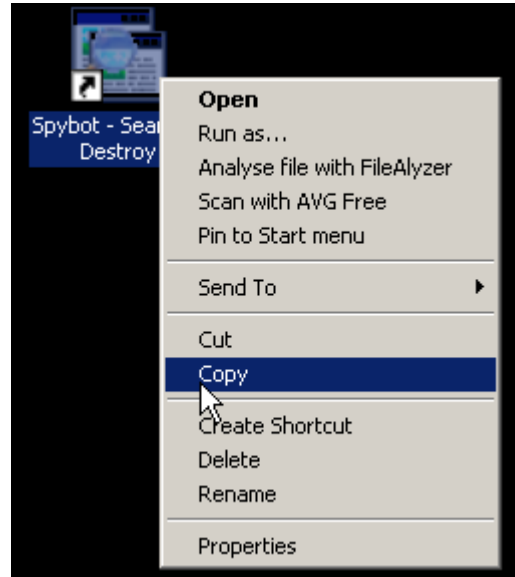

**Modify the shortcuts on your Weekly Menu:**

During Install, Spybot placed an icon on your desktop. It points to the NEW Spybot location. The icons in your weekly menu still point to the OLD location.

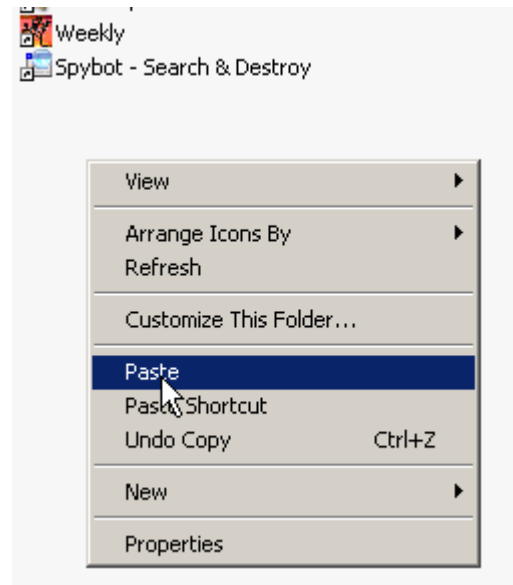
Let's fix that.

First, right click on the icon on your desktop, and "copy" it.



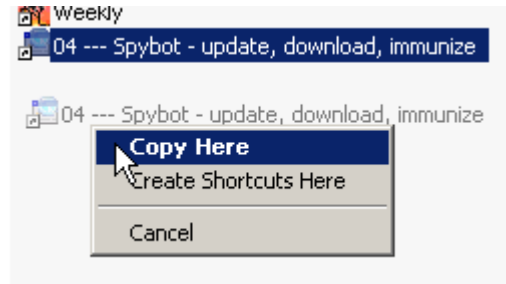
Now open the "Weekly" folder (the bottom item on your Weekly menu). Paste the Spybot icon we just copied into the weekly folder. (Rt-click & Paste)

Notice how the OLD Spybot shortcuts, (called something like: "04 - Spybot - update, download, immunize") no longer have colored icons. That's because there's no longer a program where they point.

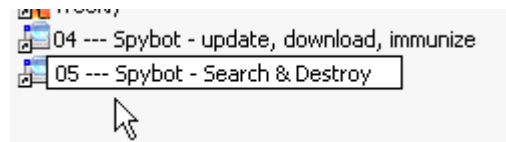


Now rename the new icon to closely match the old Spybot icon  
(if you try to make it exact, it'll fail, so add an extra dash or something).  
e.g. "04 --- Spybot - update, download, immunize"

Copy the new icon with a right-click drag,



rename it to almost match the other old icon.  
e.g. "07 -- AVG scan all"

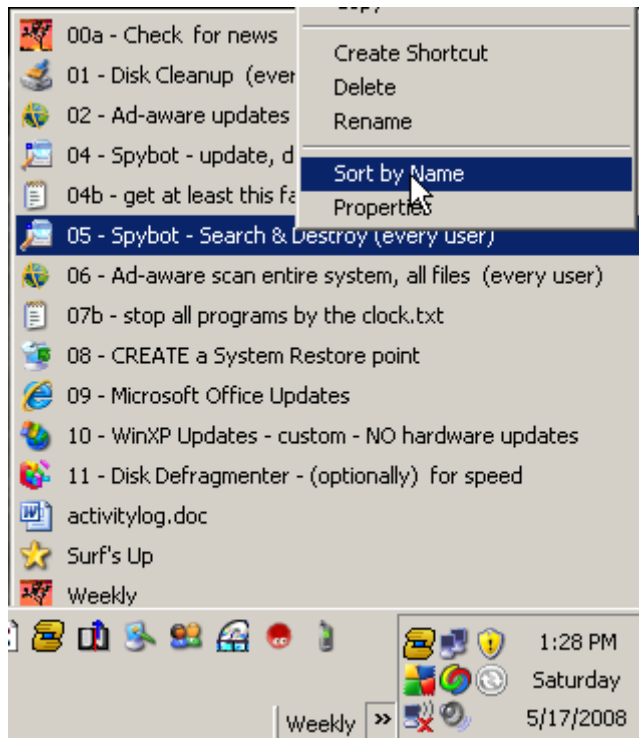


Now delete the two OLD shortcuts.

Last step:

Your "weekly" menu is now not in numerical order.

Open the menu, on your desktop, right-click any item, and select "Sort by name"
